Main emergency-supply drop-off

Former UW–Oshkosh Fox Cities Campus 1478 Midway Road, Menasha, WI 54952 Open today: 8:00 a.m.–8:00 p.m. Small vehicles should use the campus’s main entrance. Large trucks and bulk donations should enter from University Avenue.

Currently requested
